

4. Mac OSX Services - DHCP

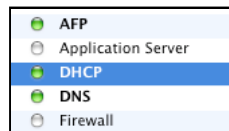
Your *Mac OS X Server* has the *Dynamic Host Control Protocol* (DHCP) service enabled.

This document describes how to adjust the scope (range) of the DHCP service.

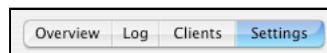
1. Launch **Server Admin**.



2. Click on the **DHCP** service in the left pane.

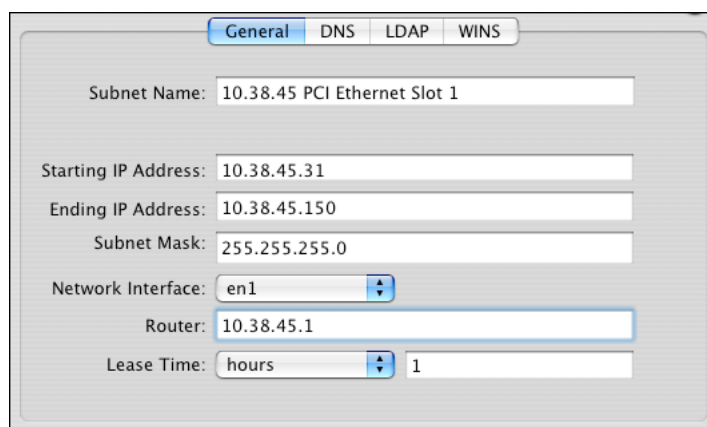


3. Click on the **Settings** button in the right pane.



Double-click on the default subnet, to display the configuration window.

4. Under the **General** tab, you can see your **DHCP range**.



Make the necessary adjustment to the DHCP scope (range). There cannot be any equipment (printers, photocopiers, computers, etc) with “fixed” IP addresses within this range.

5. Click on **Save**, and restart the *DHCP* service when prompted.
